The World Record Attempt Day

Here's all you need to know about the World Record Attempt.

Sunday 2nd May 2010 around Brixham Harbour

[As soon as you arrive](#)

Find a registration point to complete a registration form (and consent form if required).

[1:45pm](#)

Go to one of the entrance stations marked on the map to be checked-in to the gathering area.

[2:15pm \(approx\)](#)

Record attempt starts. All pirates must remain in the gathering area to take part in the record attempt.

[2:30pm \(approx\)](#)

Record attempt finishes. You will be free to enjoy the rest of the festival.

Important Notes

Registration and consent forms must be completed before you take them to an entrance station for check-in to the gathering area.

You should expect to be inside the gathering area for up to half an hour once the record attempt time begins. Please be patient and bring snacks!

The check-in process can take a while, we will get you through to the gathering area as quickly as we can.

After the count, certificates verifying your attendance at the world record attempt will be available (£1 towards festival costs) from our stands and from some local businesses.

What to wear

If you are taking part in the record attempt you must clearly resemble a pirate, this is what you need to wear throughout the attempt ...

A pirate style hat ((or bandana/kerchief). An eye patch. An accessory: sword, hook, musket, skull and crossbones flag, or parrot. Appropriate shirt: striped shirt, white t-shirt or shirt. Appropriate trousers: pantaloons, tatty trousers or rolled-up trousers. Pirate style dresses/skirts for the ladies are fine too.
