The final figure was 1744 pirates which means Brixham Buccaneers have recaptured the record back from those scurvy pirates across the pond in Portland Oregon who took it from Brixham in September 2009

Brixham Buccaneers spokesmen David Croney who helped organise the attempt said “
“We are thrilled it has been verified again .The weather was against us this year but thanks to the public this did not deter them and they turned out in their hundreds. Even the Mayor Nick Bye donned his pirate gear to help us out. It was lovely.
